A Master's Degree from an accredited college or university and a standard New Jersey certificate as supervisor and learning disabilities teacher-consultant or school psychologist, or school social worker.

Reports to:

Superintendent of Schools/Assistant Superintendent of Schools

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Uphold and enforce school, administrative, board and state rules, regulations, and policies.
- 2. Coordinate and evaluate child study team activities and performance.
- 3. Coordinate and evaluate special services secretarial staff activities and performance.
- 4. Consult with building principals about special education programs.
- 5. Conduct classification and IEP conferences.
- 6. Attend to required records, reports, and other procedural matters in an appropriate and punctual manner.
- 7. Participate in curriculum and other developmental programs as assigned.
- 8. Aid in the selection and evaluation of special education materials.
- 9. Assist teachers in ordering educational materials.
- 10. Act in the capacity of liaison between school and community agencies when necessary.
- 11. Attend meetings and conferences regarding special education as necessary.
- 12. Represent the district at hearings which may be scheduled by official agencies authorized to conduct placement and review hearings.
- 13. Participate in in-service training programs.
- 14. Maintain familiarity with current trends and practices in the field of special education.
- 15. Assume responsibility for any other duties or responsibilities assigned by the Superintendent of Schools or the Assistant Superintendent of Schools.
