## Qualifications:

The position of high school special education team leader is a parttime non-supervisory position.

Certification: Teacher's certificate; experience in special education

## Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. To implement district goals and objectives.
- To uphold and enforce Board of Education rules, regulations and policies.
- 3. To assist teachers in managing student behavior within the special education classes.
- To act as a liaison between special education teaching staff and parent/guardian.
- To assist guidance counselors and LDTC with student scheduling.
- 6. To meet biweekly with special education teachers.
- 7. To meet with guidance department and child study team on a weekly basis.
- 8. To participate in related curriculum development and other programs as assigned.
- 9. To identify pupil needs and cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping pupils solve learning, social, and attitude problems.
- 10. To counsel student and parents to improve school functioning.
- 11. To meet weekly with the Director of Special Services to coordinate program planning and student activities.
- 12. To assume responsibility for any other related duties assigned by the Director of Special Services.
- Hours: Time after the school day and some evening coordination will be required.
