- Franklin Music Office Used for small-group and individual music instruction. District will contact the State as to whether or not this room can be used as an instructional space if upgraded.

  Mechanical ventilation will be needed and can be included in a future budget if State advises the district that the room will be approvable.
- Radcliffe Resource Room and Nurse's Office District will be submitting plans and specifications to the State in 1990-91 to upgrade rooms. If State approves plans, projects will take place in 1990-91 and/or 1991-92 to bring these areas into compliance.
