Quick Facts: (Financial)

■ State average per pupil budgeted in 2007-08 - \$12,806

■Nutley Schools per pupil budgeted in 2007-08 - \$10,945

□\$1,861 less than the state average budgeted in Nutley

■83rd lowest of 104 in spending (K-12 Statewide)

Quick Facts: (Financial)

Administrative Spending -

- ■State average per pupil budgeted 2007-08 \$1,319
- ■Nutley average per pupil budgeted 2007-08 \$1,269
- ■8th lowest out of 12 of the K-12 districts in Essex County of similar size

More Quick Facts: (Educational)

- ■97% HSPA pass rate for Language Arts (Increase of 5.3% over prior year)
- ■88% HSPA pass rate for Mathematics (Increase of 3.6% over prior year)
- ■GEPA Results Nutley out-performed the state average in both Language Arts & Mathematics

More Quick Facts: (Educational)

■96.7% NJASK pass rate for Grade 3 Language Arts & Mathematics

(Increase of 3.7% over prior year)

■93.8% NJASK pass rate for Grade 4 Language Arts & Mathematics

(Increase of 2% over prior year)

Capital Projects:

- ■Purchase of land and site improvements for a parking lot behind the middle school
- Lights in the athletic field (The Oval)
- Flag pole replacements: high school, middle school and athletic field

■ Total budget is \$59,560,518

■ State Aid increase of 20% from 2007-08

■NO reductions in academic programs

Approximate average assessed home value in Nutley for 2008 is \$403,500

Total tax increase of 5.78%
