As a result of recent changes in the status of our previously-approved NCAA core courses, it is necessary to implement name and curricular changes to existing courses. The purpose of this is to meet requirements set by the NCAA Eligibility Center for Division I and Division II student athletes. The changes we suggest are as follows:

In conjunction with title changes, the intention is to enhance the curriculum for the addressed courses. Further, recent changes in State Department of Education graduation requirements mandate that all students complete a minimum of one year of Algebra I beginning with the Class of 2012.

It is also recommended that a modification of special education/inclusion course titles be made to safeguard the privacy of students with learning disabilities. The changes we suggest are as follows:

The distinction between the proposed Special Ed titles and Regular Ed titles will be in the course number only, i.e., English I - 101 (regular ed), English I - 033 (special ed).
