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- Eight Core Elements with Indicators
- Rubric (40 pages) with Rating Categories, Criteria, and Sample Documentation
- Rating Categories Scale 0-3
 - 0 = Does Not Meet the Requirements
 - 1 = Partially Meets the Requirements
 - 2 = Meets All Requirements
 - **3 = Exceeds All Requirements**
- > Sufficient Documentation must be maintained to substantiate ratings for each indicator.



➤ Core Element #1: HIB Programs, Approaches or Other Initiatives

<u>5 Indicators</u>: Establish, implement and assess programs, approaches, initiatives; programs, approaches, initiatives prevent and address HIB; SST identifies and reviews school climate.

➤ Core Element #2: Training on the BOE – approved HIB Policy & Procedures

<u>3 Indicators</u>: Employees trained; training on protected characteristics; discussed with students.

➤ Core Element #3: Other Staff Instruction and Training Programs

<u>5 Indicators</u>: Instruction on HIB and suicide prevention (2 hours);
ABS provided in-service training; SST provided PD; school leaders' training.

➤ Core Element #4: Curriculum and Instruction on HIB and Related Information and Skills

2 Indicators: Ongoing, age-appropriate instruction according to CCCS; observed Week of Respect.

≻Core Element #5: HIB Personnel

•3 Indicators: ABSs appointed by principals and met with ABC 2x per year; SST met 2x per year.

➤ Core Element #6: School-Level HIB Incident Reporting Procedure

•2 Indicators: Implemented the district's procedures for reporting HIB incidents and new information on a prior HIB report.

➤ Core Element #7: HIB Investigation Procedure

•4 Indicators: Notification to parents; completion of the investigation in 10 days; preparation of written report; results of investigation to superintendent within 2 school days.

➤Core Element #8: HIB Reporting

•2 Indicators: Procedure for ensuring staff member reports (verbal and written) include required information; official grades from DOE are posted on each school's homepage.

➤ Upon BOE approval granted, the ratings for each school are formally submitted to the NJDOE.

- > Formal submission includes:
 - 1. Mr. Lazovick's certification of each school's electronically submitted ratings and
- 2. the *Statement of Assurances* including the BOE approval date.

Public Reporting and Review of the Grades

For Grades received by a school and the district shall be posted on the homepage of the school's website and the district's website within 10 days of notification.

➤ Grades will be reviewed with the BOE at a public meeting.
