From the Minutes of the BOE Meeting of June 25th, 2002, "New Business", Mr. Joseph C. Pelaia:

[...] However, communication is not just something that we as a Board must be concerned about during a Referendum. This must be a process that takes place all year long on all the issues that confront the Board. Accordingly, I am now proposing that the Nutley Board of Education adopt a package of communications initiatives to meet this need.

1. Use the District's current Web site to list the meeting schedule of the Board of Education including the location and time of each meeting. This will enable the community to plan ahead and attend our meetings. This simple step will also enable us to effectively communicate the dates and times of any special meetings that are held.

2. Further, we should also post the approved minutes of our regular and special Board meetings on the District's Web site. This will permit those individuals unable to attend a meeting, as well as those unable to attend any meetings, the opportunity to keep abreast of important actions that the Board takes, decisions and reports made by the Superintendent, and the comments of their neighbors who do attend and speak at our meetings.

3. The District should televise its public meetings. These meetings can be shown on a tape-delayed basis on public access television several times between each Board meeting. [...]

June 25th, 2002 Resolution:

[...] that the Board adopt a practice of placing on its web site its meeting agenda, the time and place of special meetings, as well in advance as humanly possible, and the approved minutes by the Board within 24 to 48 hours upon approval. The motion was unanimously approved by the Board.



June 27, 1966

VANTACAW SCHOOL-GRAMMAR.








YANTAGAW SCHOOL.













As these buildings became seriously crowded, the Yantacaw building was added in 1902. This building consisted of cight classroors, two teachers' roors, and a library. Again crowding forced the town to build the second part of the front of Park School in 1907. Park Hall had been partially destroyed by fire in 1904, and the Homestead was vacated in 1902 as Yantacaw was completed. The school plant chen consisted of Church Street, Yantacaw, and the ealarged Park School.

The Town of Nutley was now growing rapidly, and in six years three new buildings were erected, i.e., Washington in 1911 with nine rooms and auditorium; Lincoln in 1915 with eight rooms, two play rooms, nurse's and teachers' rooms; and Spring Garden in 1917 with eight rooms. So in 1917 our school plant consisted of Park (front section complete), Yantacaw, Washington, Lincoln and Spring Garden (original sections), and Church Street.


1 WA8HINGTON 2 CHURCH STREET 3 SPRING GARDEN 4 PARK 5 LINCOLN 6 YANTACAW As the town continued to grow, additions were necessary at Park in 1923 (rear of building), at Spring Garden and Washington in 1927, and at Lincoln and Yantacaw in 1929. This completed the present elementary, buildings. While these developments were underway, the new High School building was being erected, and was occupied in October, 1927. At this rime the Church Street School, which had been used as a trade school during the decade 1917 to 1927, was closed.


Therefore, Nutley's present plant, in use for more than twenty years, consists of Park (now the Junior High School), Yantacaw, Washington, Lincoln, Spring Garden, and the High School.


 1 SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL
 4 JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL


 2 YANTACAW

 6 WASHINGTON


