Investigation Findings


- Non-HIB Event (Unfounded)


H.I.B. Statistics January 2024 – June 2024

Total Number of HIB Cases Investigated: 70






Elementary Level January 2024 – June 2024



JHWMS and NHS January 2024 – June 2024




JHWMS and NHS Protected Characteristics

Consequences & Remedial Measures January 2024 – June 2024
