2025/2026 Budget

Finance Resolution #1

WHEREAS, In anticipation of the FY2026 Appropriations Act including specific authorization, the Department of Education is offering applications to certain school districts to request authority from the Commissioner of Education to increase expenditures, and

WHEREAS, under this provision, the Commissioner may direct certain school districts to increase expenditures in order to satisfy the thoroughness and efficiency standards established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-46, and

WHEREAS, a district is eligible to apply for the authority to increase expenditures if it is both taxing below its local fair share and spending below adequacy, as defined pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-70, and

WHEREAS, Nutley Board of Education is eligible to apply for \$16,535,033 since it is taxing below its local fair share and spending below adequacy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nutley Board of Education approves the submission of the application to increase district expenditure pursuant to the language provision in the proposed FY2026 budget to the state in the amount of \$2,615,000 for the tax levy portion and \$130,750 for the tax levy incentive aid portion for a total increase of \$2,745,750.
