Special meeting of the Board of Education of Franklin Township held in the Park School house on Friday evening Feb 22/1901 Meeting called to order by the President Mr John F. Clark Members present Messrs Clark Pond, Marsh, Booth and Ackerman The Dist Clerk C. B. Vandewater being absent Mr W. Ackerman was elected Dist Clerk pro tem.

Letter from Geo W. Symonds relative to school site read and placed on file.

Resolved that the District Clerk be instructed to notify Council to Commence Condemnation proceedings to ^{obtain} possession of the portion of the Estate of J. A. Stager dec'd set forth in a Call for a public meeting held in Park School house on Dec 21-1900. Carried unanimously, The Building Com reported they had selected Mr C. G. Jones as the Architect.

Resolved that the report of the ^{Building} Com be Accepted. Carried

Resolved that the plans submitted by Mr C. G. Jones be accepted and that Mr C. G. Jones be and hereby is chosen as the Architect and that his compensation shall be 5% of the cost of construction of said building. Unanimously Carried. Resolved that the Building Com be instructed to advertise for bids and that each bid for the work be accompanied by a certified check in the amount of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Bids to be opened at a special meeting of the Board on Monday Mch 4th 1901 at 8.30 P.M.
