Complaint from town Council regarding the sanitary condition of Avondale School *Room* - and by motion referred to Building Committee.

Moved by Booth seconded by DR. Philhow~~er~~ that the President and clerk be authorized to issue a note for \$2500 (twenty five hundred dollars) for four months, interest 5% per *annum* ~~month~~ *carried*

The Water bill was discussed and as the amount seemed excessive, it was moved by Dittig seconded by Booth that a warrant be draw for amt. of bill less (10.00), *carried*.
