TUITION RATES FOR OUT-OF-TOWN PUPILS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR
1970-1971:

Mr. Ohlson presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mrs. Peddieson, and unanimously approved by the Board:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Town of Nutley, New Jersey, County of Essex, that it hereby sets the yearly tuition rates for out-of-town pupils who attend the Nutley Schools during the 1970-1971 School Year at \$655.00 per student for grades kindergarten through sixth and \$857.00 per student for grades seven through twelve, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Board of Education hereby sets the tuition fees to be charged to the sending districts for its students who will attend trainable classes in the Nutley School System at \$2,150.00 per student for the School Year 1970-1971.
