Board of Education Nutley, New Jersey February 27, 1978

#### ROLL CALL:

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by the Secretary, Temporary Chairman. The Secretary, Mr. Arnold C. Ramsland, called the roll. Members present at roll call were: Mrs. Roy Imhoff, Mr. Walter Lindstrom, Mr. Carl Perez, Mrs. Bernard Rabinowitz, Mr. Gerard T. Restaino, Mr. Robert Rusignuolo, Mr. Frank V. Tangorra, Mrs. John Wightman, and Mr. Louis F. Williams. Approximately 20 citizens were present.

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF PURPOSE OF MEETING:

Mr. Ramsland, temporary chairman, read the following:

"Pursuant to the provisions of N. J. S. A. 18A:10-3, the organization meeting of the new Board of Education of the Town of Nutley will be held on Monday evening, February 27, 1978, at 8:00 p. m., in the Board Room, Administration Building, 149 Chestnut Street, Nutley.

"The purpose of this meeting is to organize the new Board of Education and to transact such other business as may come before the Board."

## ADMINISTRATION OF OATH TO NEW BOARD MEMBERS:

Mr. Ramsland administered the Oath of Office to Mrs. Ann Rabinowitz, Mr. Carl Perez and Mr. Louis F. Williams.

# ELECTION OF PRESIDENT:

Mr. Ramsland assumed the chair and announced that the first item of business on the agenda will be the election of officers for the coming year. Nominations are open for the office of President. Mr. Ramsland commented that a second was not necessary for a nomination but if anyone would like to second a name, he would accept it.

Mrs. Wightman placed the name of Mr. Louis Williams in nomination for President, seconded by Mr. Lindstrom. Mrs. Wightman commented that in her opinion Mr. Williams had demonstrated an ability and a thoroughness on a wide range of Board functions, going from negotiations to athletics to curriculum. Most importantly, she feels that Mr. Williams will continue the fine tradition that Mr. Lindstrom had started because he carries the same kind of objective, cool and with dignity about him.

Mr. Perez nominated Mr. Gerard T. Restaino for President, seconded by Mr. Tangorra. #### ELECTION OF VICE-PRESIDENT:

Mr. Ramsland asked for nominations for the position of Vice-President.

Mr. Restaino placed the name of Carl Perez in nomination for Vice-President. He commented that in the three years Mr. Perez had served on the Board of Education he has been more than dedicated, he has been honest, upright, and an outstanding Board member.

Mrs. Imhoff placed the name of Gerard Restaino in nomination for Vice-President. Mr. Restaino declined the nomination.

Mr. Restain moved that nominations be closed, seconded by Mrs. Wightman. The motion was carried by a unanimous affirmative vote.

There being only one nominee, the chair directed the Secretary to cast a unanimous ballot for Mr. Perez as Vice-President of the Board of Education.

Mr. Williams commented that he was honored to be elected as President and would continue to strive for quality education in Nutley and maintain the high stature and integrity of the Board. He thanked Mr. Lindstrom and Mr. Restaino for their leadership during their terms as President and Vice-President.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Town of Nutley as follows:

- 1. The firm of Haskins & Sells is hereby appointed auditors for the accounts of the Board of Education for the 1978-1979 school year.
- 2. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional service under the provisions of the Public School Contracts Law because said services are of an extraordinary, unspecifiable nature which cannot reasonably be described by written specifications, and require specialized expertise, extensive training, and proven reputation in the field.

#### APPOINTMENT OF ATTORNEY:

Mrs. Rabinowitz presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mrs. Wightman. Upon being put to a roll call vote the resolution was adopted with Mr. Williams, Mrs. Imhoff, Mr. Lindstrom, Mr. Perez, Mrs. Rabinowitz, Mr. Rusignuolo, Mr. Tangorra, and Mrs. Wightman voting aye and Mr. Restaino voting nay.

- 1. Mr. C. Russell Kramer of the firm of Smith, Kramer and Morrison is hereby appointed Board attorney for the 1978-1979 school year.
- 2. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional service under the provisions of the Public School Contracts Law because said services are of an extraordinary, unspecifiable nature which cannot reasonably be described by written specifications, and require specialized expertise, extensive training, and proven reputation in the field.

#### DEPOSITORY OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SAVINGS ACCOUNTS:
