A Special Meeting of the Board of Education of the Township of Nutley, New Jersey, was held in the Board Room, 375 Bloomfield Avenue, on Monday, January 10, 1983, at 8:10 p.m., with Mrs. Ann Rabinowitz, President, presiding.

FLAG SALUTE:

The meeting was opened with Mr. Malanga leading the Board members and citizens in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF ADEQUATE NOTICE:

Mrs. Rabinowitz read the following notice:

"As required by the 'Open Public Meetings Act' (Chapter 231, P.L. 1975), notice of this meeting was provided to the public and the press by being included in the Annual Schedule of Meetings which was adopted at the Organization Meeting held on April 26, 1982, and

1. Posted at the entrance of the Board offices.
2. Mailed or delivered to The Nutley Sun, the Newark-Star Ledger, and the Passaic Herald News, and
3. Delivered to the Nutley Township Clerk."

CALL OF ROLL:

The other members present at roll call were: Dr. Anthony N. Baratta, Mr. Douglas Eisenfelder, Mrs. Jacqueline Imhoff, Mr. Charles W. Kucinski, Jr., Mr. Joseph Malanga, Mr. Carl Perez and Mr. Frank V. Tangorra. Absent and excused: Mr. Louis F. Williams. One citizen was present.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF PURPOSE OF MEETING:

Mrs. Rabinowitz read the following notice:

"The purpose of this meeting is to adopt a tentative budget for the operation of the school district for the 1983-1984 school year, and to transact any other business which may properly come before the Board."

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

None

ADOPTION OF TENTATIVE BUDGET:

Mr. Eisenfelder presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Malanga. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A., 18A:7A-28, as amended, requires the preparation on or before January 15, 1983 of a school budget for the ensuing year,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education hereby adopts a tentative budget for the 1983-1984 school year in the total amount of:

Current Expense	\$14,223,576
Debt Service	<u>221,325</u>
Total	\$14,444,901

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary be authorized to submit this budget to the County Superintendent for his examination to determine that all the information submitted therein is verifiable from records on file in his office and is consistent with such records, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon receiving the approval of the County Superintendent the Secretary be authorized to publish the 1983-1984 Budget in THE NUTLEY SUN.

Dr. Fadule and Mr. Ramsland reviewed the proposed budget, and explained the reasons for the major increases.

BILLS AND MANDATORY PAYMENTS:

Mr. Eisenfelder presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Perez. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education authorizes the payment of bills and mandatory payments in the total amount of \$644,746.86 as per the attached Schedule A which have been audited by the Business Department.

CHANGE OF MEETING DATES:

Mr. Tangorra presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Eisenfelder, and unanimously approved by the Board:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the regular January and February, 1983 meetings of the Board of Education be moved back one week as follows:

January 24, 1983 change to January 31, 1983

February 28, 1983 change to March 7, 1983 to be combined with the Public Hearing on the Budget.

ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion made by Mr. Tangorra, seconded by Mr. Kucinski, the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
