A Special Meeting of the Board of Education of the Township of Nutley, New Jersey, was held in the Board Room, 375 Bloomfield Avenue, on Monday, January 21, 1985, at 8:30 p.m., with Mr. Gerard T. Restaino, President, presiding.

FLAG SALUTE:

The meeting was opened with Mr. Piro leading the Board members in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

CALL OF ROLL:

The other members present at roll call were: Dr. Anthony N. Baratta, Mr. Sam Battaglia, Mr. Frank V. Hermo, Mr. Charles W. Kucinski, Jr., Mr. Joseph Malanga, Mr. Charles J. Piro, Mr. Robert J. Rusignuolo, and Mrs. Rosalie C. Scheckel.

APPOINTMENT - Part-Time School Aide:

Mrs. Margaret Ross

Mr. Kucinski presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Dr. Baratta. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, That Mrs. Margaret Ross be appointed part-time school aide at the hourly rate of \$4.50, step 1, effective January 8, 1985, in accordance with the 1984/1985 part-time school aide guide.

APPOINTMENTS - Teachers, Scholastic Aptitude Tests Classes - High School:

Dr. Baratta presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Kucinski. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the following teachers be appointed to teach Scholastic Aptitude Tests classes at the high school at the rate of \$60 per session on the following Saturday mornings - January 26, February 2, 9, March 2, 9, 16, 1985:

Mr. Ronald Bonadonna - English
 Mr. John Suffren - Mathematics

TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT - [REDACTED]: [REDACTED]

Mrs. Scheckel presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Rusignuolo. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] was suspended with pay on January 8, 1985 for failure to perform his [REDACTED] duties satisfactorily after repeated warnings and attempts at remediation, and

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] was provided with an opportunity to present his version of the matter before the Board of Education, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education afforded [REDACTED] a hearing at an executive session of the Nutley Board of Education on January 21, 1985, and

WHEREAS, there exists good cause for invoking the 60 day termination provision of [REDACTED]'s employment contract, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That [REDACTED]'s employment with the Nutley Board of Education shall be terminated effective March 22, 1985, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That [REDACTED] is hereby suspended with pay during the sixty day period.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION - [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

Mr. Rusignuolo presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mrs. Scheckel. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has considered the recommendation of the Superintendent to require [REDACTED], a [REDACTED] at Nutley High School, to undergo a physical examination at Board expense utilizing a Board appointed physician, and

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has in the past and continues to be absent because of alleged [REDACTED], and

WHEREAS, the Board has afforded [REDACTED] a full opportunity to appear before the Board to discuss this matter, and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered the documentation provided by the Superintendent,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That [REDACTED] submit to a physical examination at a time and place to be reasonably set by the Board in order to fully and completely ascertain the nature and severity of [REDACTED]'s illness, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon reviewing said report and prognosis, the Board will determine what further action, if any, is required and/or appropriate.

ADJOURNMENT:


There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion made by Mr. Kucinski, seconded by Mr. Malanga, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
