"Status Reports:

School Calendar - Dr. Fadule

Dr. Fadule stated that 184 student days had been scheduled for the 1986/1987 school year, and we have used two snow days so far. The State of New Jersey requires at least 180 days of school.

Curriculum Priorities - Dr. Votto

Dr. Votto reported that last Saturday, the 7th session of the Saturday curriculum meetings was held. Six groups met in various curriculum meetings and are in the process of making final drafts for Board review in coming months. As Mr. Restaino had suggested, one session was taped. The High School Standards Committee has almost completed its report, and an initial response has been made to it.

Budget - Mr. Sincaglia"

Mr. Sincaglia stated that it was hoped that a meeting could be held next Monday night for the tentative adoption of the 1987-88 budget, however, the Governor will not be making his budget statement until next Monday, and figures will not be available until that time and possibly later. The deadline for submission of the budget to

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the County Office is still February 9. Mr. Sincaglia recommended that the Board meet on Wednesday, February 4 to adopt the tentative budget. This was agreed to by the Board.


NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Piro, representative to the Washington School P.T.A., stated that because of his work schedule he finds it impossible to attend the meetings, and he requested that another representative be named.


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ADJOURNMENT:
