## ADOPTION OF TENTATIVE BUDGET:

Mr. Piro presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mrs. Goodson. On a roll call vote the resolution was unanimously adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education hereby adopts a tentative budget for the 1993/1994 school year in the amount of:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary be authorized to submit this budget to the County Superintendent for approval, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED. That upon receiving the approval of the County Superintendent, the Secretary be authorized to publish the 1993/1994 budget in The Nutley Sun.

Mr. Kucinski made a statement indicating that the budget that was being approved was \$268,748 under cap, and he thanked the Committee and administration for all the hard work that was done in reducing over \$1,500,000 from the original proposals to get the budget down to this level.

Mr. Sincaglia then stated that the budget represented an increase of 4.3% from 1992/1993 and reiterated some of the comments made by Mr. Kucinski.

Mr. Battaglia announced that the Public Hearing on the budget would be on April 5, 1993.
