The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of the Township of Nutley, New Jersey was held in the Board Room, 375 Bloomfield Avenue, on Monday, June 28, 1993 at 8:00 p.m., with Mr. Sam P. Battaglia, President, presiding.

Mr. Battaglia read the following:

Mr. Sincaglia explained the adjustments made this year in determining the cost of education, adding that Nutley does very well by any measure of statistics. He indicated that Nutley does a good job at a low cost.

CAFETERIA REPORT:

Mrs. Goodson presented the cafeteria report as of May 31, 1993 showing a cash balance as of July 1, 1992 of \$6,169.18, total receipts of \$363,036.15, total disbursements of \$363,459.66, leaving a cash balance of \$5,745.67.
