The Conference Meeting of the Board of Education of the Township of Nutley, New Jersey was held in the Board Room, 375 Bloomfield Avenue, on Monday, July 20, 1998 at 7:15 p.m. with Mr. Joseph C. Pelaia, President, presiding.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF ADEQUATE NOTICE:

Mr. Pelaia read the following:

CALL OF ROLL:

The members present at roll call were: Dr. Philip T. Casale, Mrs. Michele Fleitell, Mr. Vincent Moscaritola, Mr. Steven P. Picciano, Mrs. Maria Russo, Mr. Louis F. Williams and Mr. Joseph C. Pelaia. Absent: Mr. Alfred R. Restaino, Jr. and Mr. Robert J. Rusignuolo.

1. Mr. Sincaglia distributed replacement page #5 for Policy 501/ 5111, Eligibility of Resident/Nonresident Pupils, and explained that this reflected the concerns expressed by Board members at the Special Conference Meeting of July 6.

He indicated that what should happen at the regular meeting would be moving this page as an amendment to the proposed policy. Assuming the Board was in agreement, the policy would then be considered to have had a first reading at tonight's meeting and a second reading at the August meeting.

After a short discussion it was agreed that this item should be included as an amendment to the current policy.

2. Mr. Sincaglia distributed copies of the Treasurer's Report noting that it could not be completed because we were doing close out and the accelerated meeting schedule had not allowed it to be completed before the packets went out. He further noted that the Treasurer's Report had been inserted in the public's packets.
