## CALL OF ROLL:

The members present at roll call were: Dr. Philip T. Casale, Mrs. Michele Fleitell, Mr. Vincent Moscaritola, Mr. Steven P. Picciano, Mr. Alfred R. Restaino, Jr., Mrs. Maria Russo and Mr. Joseph C. Pelaia. Late: Dr. Joseph P. Scarpelli (7:12 p.m.).

1. Mr. Pelaia asked Mr. Sincaglia to go over the updated impact study concerning the Cambridge Heights development. Mr. Sincaglia explained the new tables that had been developed by Dr. Richardson in concert with himself and Dr. Serafino. Mr. Sincaglia noted that the situation at Yantacaw School did not vary whether or not the two or three bedroom concept was used as far as number of classrooms was concerned. What did change was the number of pupils per class.

The other changes required additional rooms at Franklin School and the high school although Mr. Sincaglia noted that the high school impact would not require any physical adjustments. Mr. Sincaglia also noted, however, that the overall projected enrollment at the high school seemed to show that the idea of shifting a grade there would not be that simple given the anticipated growth that is expected to occur.

Dr. Scarpelli entered during this discussion

After several comments it was moved by Mrs. Fleitell to accept the draft report, seconded by Mr. Moscaritola and unanimously approved by the Board.
