Student Performance Data

Mr. Bania and Mrs. Loconsolo gave a power-point presentation on the student performance data.

Criteria for District Ranking

Ms. Karen Greco gave a power-point presentation on district ranking.

There was a question and answer period after each presentation.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Glazer spoke about "Start with Hello Week" and other activities throughout the district and township. She acknowledged the Buildings & Grounds Department for their work with the Washington School trailers over the weekend and thanked Dave Berry and Carl Thunell for their help.

BOARD SECRETARY'S REPORT

Mrs. Yeamans spoke about the new food service company and the different food selections. She said the 2018-2019 audit is underway as well as the fixed assets inventory.

DIRECTOR OF BUILDINGS & GROUNDS REPORT

Mr. Parigi reported on the trailers at Washington School and Spring Garden School. He thanked Mayor Scarpelli and Mike Luzzi for their assistance in cleaning the Washington School playground and help to remove 50 yards of construction dirt. He said they are building 3 new ticket booths for the Park Oval and doing several repairs being made there. He said all repairs have been made on the bathroom stalls at the high school. He reported that interviews were being held for several buildings and grounds openings.

Trustee Kucinski acknowledged the team effort by the district and town to get the trailers up and running for the students.

President Carnicella asked about the status of the locks on the bathroom stall doors at the high school.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Administration Committee - Trustee Kucinski said Dr. Glazer updated the committee on the status of the double-decked trailer at Washington School, reviewed the interview process for the Business Administrator and Assistant Business Administrator and shared additional information and materials for the district's application for Emergency Aid. The committee discussed previous demographic studies, construction proposals and building needs in preparation for the Long Range Facilities meeting on October 1, 2019. Dr. Glazer reviewed staffing, personnel, student items and legal matters.

Academic Committee - Trustee Zarro said Mrs. Loconsolo shared the district's New Jersey Student Learning Assessment, gave an update on plans for the professional development on October 11th and shared information on the NJ Department of Human Services school climate and safety survey that will be administered anonymously to select middle school students on mental health trends. The committee reviewed field trip and professional development requests.

Finance Committee - Trustee DeMaio said Mrs. Yeamans and Mr. Marmora reviewed the September 23, 2019 Finance Resolutions including transfers. Dr. Glazer reviewed several facility-use requests and potential security issues that need to be addressed with each group. Mr. Marmora reported on the status of the on-site audit and various reports that were generated for their review. Dr. Glazer reviewed personnel recommendations. Mr. Ferraro initiated a discussion regarding the planting of trees along the ball field at Washington School.

Policy Committee - Trustee Zarro reported that the committee reviewed the Class Size Policy previously approved in June. Mrs. Loconsolo shared new information on Policy 5561 Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion Techniques. A number of policies were reviewed and updated where necessary.
