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## PROMOTION FROM EIGHTH GRADE

### 5411 PROMOTION FROM EIGHTH GRADE

The Board of Education will recognize with fitting ceremonies a student's completion of the program of studies offered by this district in middle school and the student's entrance to secondary school.

Successful completion of the program of studies in middle school requires achievement of the instructional objectives set for each course of study, demonstration of mastery of the proficiencies established for each course, and a satisfactory attendance record. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of a student who may be prevented from being promoted shall be so notified in advance and no later than four (4) weeks prior to the close of the school year. Every effort shall be made to remediate a student's deficiencies before promotion is denied.

The requirements for promotion from middle school of a disabled student shall be set forth in the student's individualized education program. Completion of those specialized requirements shall qualify the student for promotion and entry to secondary school.
