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R 2230 COURSE GUIDES

A course guide will be prepared for each course of study to be taught in this district. Course guides should be and organized to provide sequential learning planned experiences in the grade levels concerned.

Preparation Α.

- preparation of course quides responsibility of school administration and staff.
- Course guides are best developed with the assistance 2. of the teaching staff members who will use them. Accordingly, appropriate staff representatives will be appointed to committees to study, revise, and/or develop course quides.
- In grades nine through twelve, pupils may be asked 3. to participate in the development and revision of course quides.

В. Content

- Course objectives should be broad statements related 1. to district educational goals and arising from the philosophy of the course.
- Performance goals should be specific statements of 2. objectives, that is, the behavioral skills, attitudes, and appreciation's to be achieved. The degree of specificity should be achieved. consistent with the nature of the course.
- 3. Teaching strategies should include. specific appropriate, instructional methods/modalities, the time to be spent on tasks, recommended pupil activities, and resources.
- Evaluation techniques should include such specific techniques as sample tests, suggested projects or performance outcomes, and individual study.

C. Implementation

Teachers will adhere to the content of course guides in accordance with Policy No. 2230.
